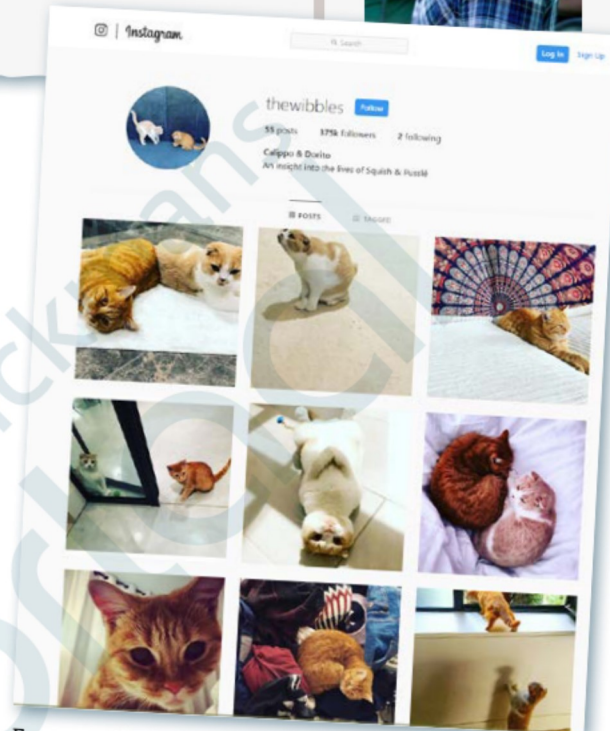
Ed Sheeran's cats now have Instagram
